

# Certification of marine equipment according to Directive 2014/90/EU

DMT Certification Body: MED / Notified body 2509

In order for products such as fire protection equipment to be used on ships flying European flags, they must undergo the EC conformity assessment procedure described in the **Marine Equipment Directive 2014/90/EU**. Depending on the selected module combination, you as the customer will receive corresponding certificates at the end of the procedure, e.g.

- an EC type-examination certificate (module B) and
- a certificate of conformity with regard to quality assurance in relation to the production process (Module D) or the product (Module E). Alternatively, a verification of the products (Module F) or an EC-Unit verification (Module G) can be applied.

Upon receipt of the two "certificates", you as the manufacturer (dealer) are authorized to place the "Wheelmark" on the product.

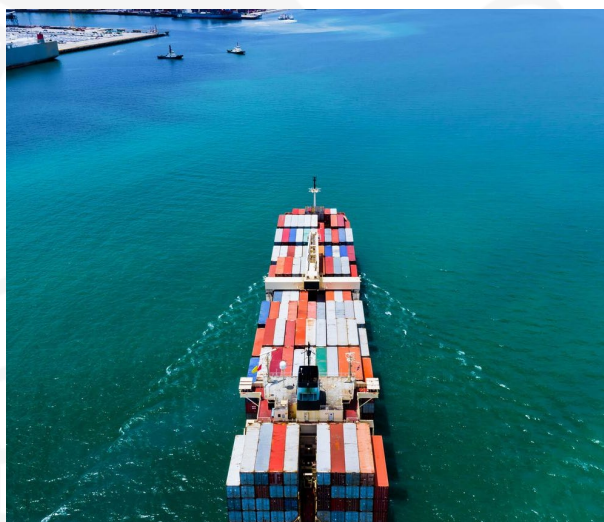
As part of DMT GmbH & Co. KG, the DMT **Certification Body** is a Notified Body according to § 3 of the Marine Equipment Ordinance (SchAusrV). The DMT Certification Body is recognized by the Federal Maritime and Hydrographic Agency (BSH) and has been listed by the Federal Ministry of Transport and Digital Infrastructure ("BMVI") under the identification number 2509 in "Nando" (New Approach Notified and Designated Organizations). The notification applies to fire protection equipment in accordance with Directive 2014/90/EU for marine equipment.

The DMT Certification Body is thus authorized to carry out EC conformity assessments for fire protection equipment in accordance with Directive 2014/90/EU for modules B, D, E and F and to issue the corresponding certificates.
